LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF ONTARIO

Every person who solemnizes a marriage shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$500, or to imprisonment for not more than six months, or to both such fine and imprisonment, if he or she solemnizes a marriage which is not a legal marriage within the meaning of the Act. R.S.O. 1897, c. 44, s. 21. Amended.
