**TWO MEN HURLED FROM  
HIGH TRESTLE IN B.C.**

**A. Soucie and W. Lawley, of  
Vancouver, Killed Near Lil-  
looet, on Diversion Work**

Vancouver, B.C., Jan. 22.—A. Soucie and W. Lawley, of Vancouver, employed by the Pacific Great Eastern railway, were killed yesterday when they were knocked off a trestle by a swinging rail and fell hundreds of feet into a canyon at Mile 14.4, near Lillooet, B.C.

The trestle was being torn up because of a diversion made in the line and a rail which was being raised struck the two men. Both men are from Vancouver.
